It is because of her strong conviction and belief in education that this scholarship is in her honor. The Jean Schliem Scholarship Award is given to a student whose parent or guardian works for a member company of WBIA.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Jean Schliem scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1,000 to the school/university/training facility on behalf of the student. Scholarship award must be used to assist with the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other expenses connected to schooling/training.

CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS

In order to be considered for a scholarship, the student must satisfy the following minimum requirements.

- ➤ Parent (or legal guardian) is an employee of an WBIA member firm*
- ➤ Candidate must have a cumulative high school Grade Point Average (Grades 9-11) of 2.5 or greater based on a 4.0 scale.
- ➤ Candidate must have a minimum of 20 ACT score.
- ➤ Candidate must have two letters of recommendation one from an educator and one from an outside source (Not a relative).
- Candidate must have participated in extracurricular activities and provided community service activities OR must have work experience.
- ➤ Candidate must have an essay (maximum of 500 words) typed and double spaced, with individual career goals.
- > Completed application must be submitted by July 1, 2019
- Scholarship recipients must attend an accredited <u>Louisiana</u> two or four year college program.

*NOTE: If your company is a member of the WBIA with offices outside the Jefferson Parish area, the child of your employee is eligible to apply. The only requirement is that student MUST attend a school in Louisiana.
